PASTORAL LETTER

Dear BPCWAians, it is my privilege to write my first Pastoral letter to all of you. We rejoice and thank God for the manifestation of His will for BPCWA at last week's election. But having a Pastor elected in is just the beginning, not the church's end purpose.

We have much to do for our Lord. It is tempting to sit back and relax because we think all is in place now. Satan never lets down on his assault on God's church on earth, and it will only intensify. Now that BPCWA has moved into a Biblical model after many years of praying and God answering, our arch enemy will not be pleased. This is not "crying wolf" or "scare tactics" so soon after the election of a Pastor. We see this in the life of Israel in the Old Testament as well as in the New Testament church. When the people slackened after a victory, troubles and failures came. On the other hand, when the people were obedient to their Lord, blessings and progress followed. Many once faithful churches around us are falling. There is failure in the pulpits, a rejection of truth by those in the church, and love of the world in the lives of individuals and their families.

So what should we do together in BPCWA? We must now move together to a higher level of diligence, devotion, and discernment. There is no letting of the guard down in the Lord's army. The pulpit's and fellowship ministries' focus on teaching must continue to grow. And each individual's study and obedience to God's Word must not slacken. Very importantly, individuals and families must double its prayer for the church, its leaders, and worshipers. Let us pray for us to be deeply grounded in God's truth so that we can stand against the wiles of the devil. Let us pray for BPCWA to have firm and stable foundations. Let us pray for greater love for our Lord and each other. Would you pray more fervently for BPCWA, God's church?

Would you commit yourself and your family to growing in God's Word? Will you keep yourself clean and spotless so that you can be used by Him? Let us do so together for the love of Christ and His church.

The Church is purchased by the Blood of Jesus Christ. The Apostle Paul reminds Pastors in Acts 20:28, *"Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood"*. God's Church has a great and glorious purpose on earth and is His Heavenly Bride. That is why personally each day as the election date got closer, my heart grew heavier. Not because I feared not being voted in, but because the burden of under-shepherding God's flock is a not light matter. Each time I hear your address "Pastor", my heart sinks a little. Not because I do not respect the office, but because I have been made accountable to God for your spiritual well being. It is a heavy responsibility and accountability before God. But each worshiper, like me, also has his own responsibility. God gave us BPCWA in Perth. A sound church is His blessing for us. Let every member love it, treasure it, be part of it, ensure its faithfulness, and be accountable for it.

As I said at the start, having a Pastor is just the beginning and is not the end point. Let us now labour together even more fervently to unite BPCWA - English and Chinese, young and old, and new and old members. This is so that we can be more effective for the Lord's work in forwarding His kingdom, edification of saints, and upholding His Truth. Let us love the Church of God enough to strive together in unity "for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ" (Rev 1:9).
